Two urns contain balls each marked with 0, 1, or 2 in the proportions described below:

	Percentage of Balls in Urn		
	Marked 0	Marked 1	Marked 2
Urn A	0.20	0.40	0.40
Urn <i>B</i>	0.70	0.20	0.10

An urn is selected at random and two balls are selected, with replacement, from the urn. The sum of values on the selected balls is 2. Two more balls are selected from the same urn.

Determine the expected total of the two balls using Bayes' Theorem.
