The role of project manager is to provide context. The universe of what a project manager does fits into 10 areas.

1	Integration Management	Project Plan development, project plan execution, integrated change control
2	Scope Management	The process required to ensure the project includes all the work required, and only the work required, to complete the project successfully.
3	Time Management	The process required to ensure timely completion of the project. (Scheduling tasks over time).
4	Cost Management	The process required to ensure the project is completed within the approved budget.
5	Quality Management	The process required to ensure the project will satisfy the needs for which it was undertaken.
6	Human Resource Management	The process required to make the most effective use of people involved with the project.
7	Communication Management	The process for timely and accurate generation, collection, dissemination, storage and disposition of project information.
8	Risk Management	The process concerned with identifying, analyzing and responding to project risk.
9	Procurement Management	The processes required to acquire goods and services from outside the performing organization.
10	Stakeholder Management	The processes required to identify, analyze, and develop strategies for effectively engaging people that could impact or who are impacted by the project to understand and meet their needs and expectations and
