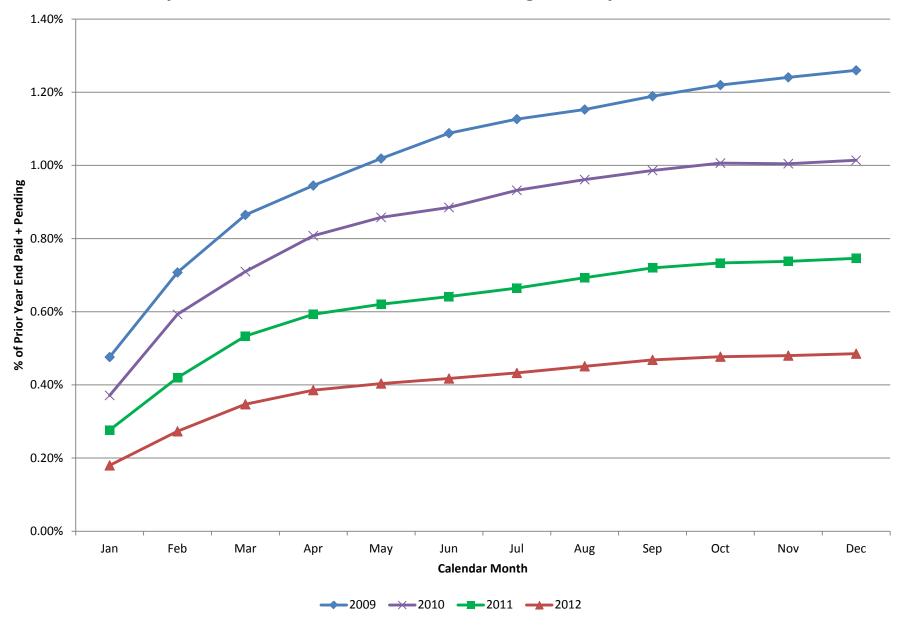

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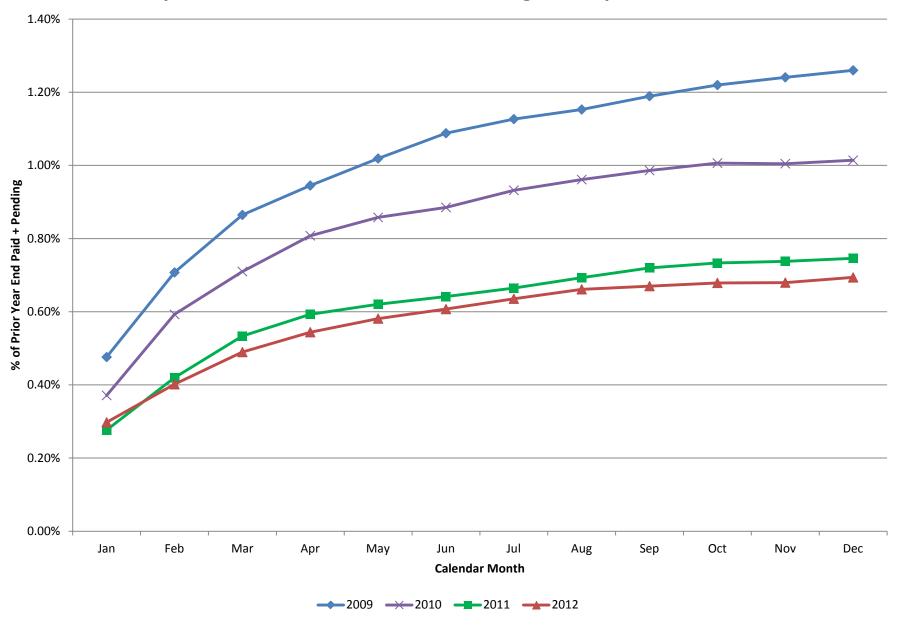
Suggestions

- Don't take 'No' for an answer

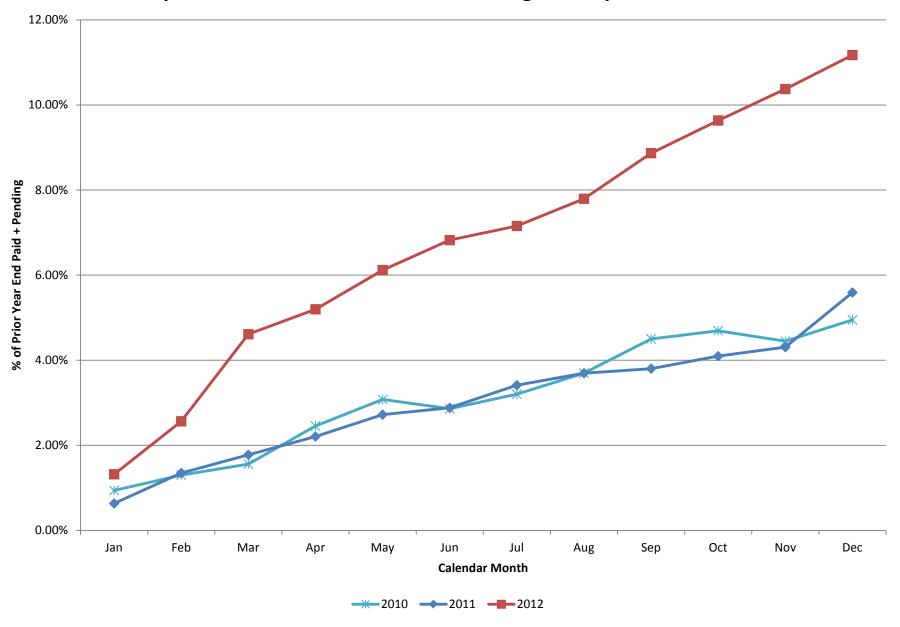
Development on Prior Accident Years during Subsequent Calendar Year
